- 6. Submissions must include the composer's contact information home/cell phone, email address, mailing address and an SASE for the return of original compositions at the end of the contest.

Cash Awards Are:

First Place – \$150 Second Place – \$75 Third Place – \$50

The three winning compositions will be presented and prizes awarded to the winners by the Valdosta Choral Guild at their Christmas concerts in early December 2011.

All compositions must be received by September 16, 2011 at P. O. Box 4842, Valdosta, GA 31604. Winners will be informed by September 23, 2011.

Following the Valdosta Choral Guild's December 2011 concerts all copies of the compositions will be the sole property of their composers.


